SCHOOL UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS (K-Yr 6 Students)

Claremont College has a fine tradition and outstanding reputation in our community for the manner in which students dress and conduct themselves both at school, when representing the school on excursions, off-site activities, sports, and when in public (during and out of school hours). Children should always wear their uniforms proudly, and parents (as part of the enrolment contract) are expected to support the uniform requirements of the school.

GENERAL UNIFORM INFORMATION

- The summer uniform is worn from January (Term 1) until mid-May (Term 2) (date announced each year) and during Term 4. The winter uniform is worn from mid-May (Term 2) until the end of Term 3.
- Uniforms must fit correctly, be clean and tidy and be in a good state of repair (i.e. buttons sewn on - additional buttons available from Ranier, blazer cuffs correct length, tunic length just below the knee).
- Full uniform (including a blazer in the winter) must be worn to and from school. If children go shopping after school, the full uniform must be worn.
- Blazers can be worn for warmth with the Summer uniform, but are only compulsory to and from school with the Winter uniform. All boys and girls now must own a unisex blazer.
- The girls' summer dress, together with the school blazer, is required for formal occasions (**including** Speech Day and School Photo Day). Boys are required to wear the white summer shirt with the plain green school tie and blazer for formal occasions (**including** Speech Day and School Photo Day).
- We have an on-site Uniform Shop. Fittings and purchases can be organised through contacting Ranier and logging into the Uniform Shop portal <https://shop.ranier.com.au/login>
- Shoes should be polished, socks pulled up, and ties done up correctly.
- Black school shoes from K to 2 can have velcro tabs or a strap style.
- School sports shoes must be predominantly white only. No coloured sneakers are allowed. Sports shoes with velcro straps are permitted for Kindergarten - Year 2.
- School bags and sports bags are used to carry all property to and from school. No other bags should be used. Stickers are not to be affixed to bags. One small key ring can be attached to assist with identification.
- The school badge, house badge and other special school badges may be worn. A plain watch may be worn (no smart watches, e.g., iWatch, Garmin, etc.).
- Earrings must be gold or silver studs only. If students wear any type of earrings other than the approved ones, they will be asked to remove them and will be sent home in an envelope.
- Boys' hair must be cut in a conventional manner and must be kept above the collar. Defined layers, ridges and very short, shaved hair are not acceptable styles. Hair must not fall across the eyes or touch the collar. If the hair is below the collar or falls across the eyes, it must be tied back.
- Girls' hair must not fall across their eyes or hang below their collars; if it does, it must be tied back. Hair accessories may include green or striped ribbons or a green or tartan headband bow on elastic and a bow on clips. All hair accessories are available for purchase from the Uniform Shop. 'Bali beads' and tight multiple braids and plaits are not permitted following holidays.
- All items of clothing (including shoes and socks) must be clearly named with labels. All other property must also be clearly named.
- All items may be purchased from Ranier with the exception of items marked 'school'.
- Badges are purchased from the school office, and all other items can be purchased from the school uniform shop.

NOTE

- All phones must be handed in at the office before 8:40 am and are not permitted to stay with the child across the school day.
- Year 6 jerseys **cannot be** worn to and from school with the school uniform. The jersey may be worn anytime at school with either uniform. Jerseys are not to be worn at special occasions such as Anzac Day services, Christmas services, etc.

Note: the wool vest may be worn with the blouse and shorts option. On formal occasions (ie School Photos and Speech Day,) girls must wear the green striped summer dress together with a unisex blazer. Plain white ankle-length socks with turnover top (no anklets or sockettes and no colour or brand names) Black school shoes – polished daily Formal Hat (School uniform shop) Unisex Blazer – not compulsory in summer except on formal occasions (School uniform shop) Hair Accessories - green or striped ribbons or a green or tartan headband, bow on elastic, and bow on clips (School uniform shop) SUMMER  During summer formal occasions, the tie and blazer are required, shirt to be tucked in. 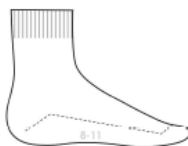
